Dr. Abby Steketee served as an IAFNS Post-Doctoral Research Fellow and contributed to media and professional outreach on scientific publications on PFAS, rare sugars and a global assessment of carbohydrate quality measures. Dr. Steketee was co-author on the publication 'Risk Assessment of Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) in Food: Symposium Proceedings', published in *Trends in Food Science & Technology*. She also was a co-author on a December 6, 2021, presentation 'Knowledge Mobilization of Food Risk and Nutrition Topics -- Some Strategies' given at the Society for Risk Analysis Annual Meeting. Additionally, Dr. Steketee was central to IAFNS' development and launch of new online tools for idea

solicitation/open innovation from the broader science community. Dr. Steketee also developed an infographic and white paper regarding oxidation of cooking oils by the food service industry. She is currently adjunct faculty at Virginia Tech in the Department of Human Nutrition, Foods and Exercise.
