Overhead Policy for Grant Applicants

IAFNS, the Institute for the Advancement of Food and Nutrition Sciences, is a public, non-profit, scientific, foundation that advances the understanding and application of science related to the nutritional quality and safety of the food supply. In the conduct of our programs IAFNS will conduct public solicitation of research proposals. Project funding requests should be consistent with the research to be conducted. Indirect costs of up to 10% of total direct costs will be considered for the management of the research project by the sponsoring institution and should be included in the total proposal (pre-proposal) budget. IAFNS does not permit indirect costs for equipment, including computers.
